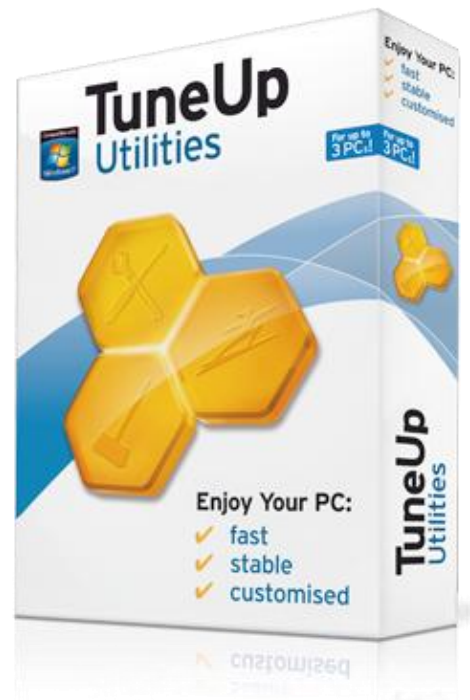
TuneUp Utilities Meets the “Compatible with Windows 7” Logo Requirements
